

Corel is looking for innovative and original clipart that is both visually appealing and technically sound.

Recognized internationally as an award-winning developer of productivity applications, graphics and Internet software, Corel has maintained an impressive growth rate by developing products that target emerging trends in the software industry.

Please note that although we certainly encourage the use of Corel products (all versions and platforms), you are not restricted to these programs. Please keep the following guidelines in mind:

CLIPART:

- ⑥ Images must open and redraw quickly and should be a maximum of 100K.
(Tip: The smaller the file size the better.)
- ⑥ Images must be vector format (not bitmap).
- ⑥ Images must NOT contain bitmap or fractal fills, lens, powerclips, transparencies or layers.
- ⑥ Images must NOT contain company logos, trademarks or identifiable individuals or entities.
- ⑥ Radial, conical and fountain fills, individual highlights and shadows are memory intensive and should be used sparingly.
(Tip: Using carefully selected blend groups and implied shading are more effective uses of resources.)
- ⑥ Images must be created using the CMYK color model. No Pantone colors.
- ⑥ All outlines must have the “Scale with Image” option selected in the pen outline dialogue box. This will ensure that the pen outline will scale proportionately when the image is scaled.
- ⑥ Outlines must be created using a round pen.
- ⑥ Text must be converted to curves.
- ⑥ Images should be approximately 3”x 3” or 75mm x 75mm in size and should be centered on the page.
- ⑥ Ensure that the default stylesheet, coreldr.cdt, is used. This stylesheet includes only the necessary styles: default artistic text, default paragraph text, default graphic and the 6 default bullets.
- ⑥ Accepted images should be saved as *.CDR (all versions) or a generic file type

ANIMATED GIFS, ICONS, BUTTONS, BANNERS, 3D OBJECTS AND WEB IMAGES:

- ⑥ .GIF or .JPG file type
- ⑥ 96 dpi resolution
- ⑥ Black, white or transparent background
- ⑥ Undithered
- ⑥ Progressive
- ⑥ Less than 50K file size
- ⑥ Meaningful first and last frames (animated GIFs)
- ⑥ Single or infinite looping (animated GIFs)

PAGE SETUP:

- ⑥ Paper color must be white.
- ⑥ 8.5” x 11” or A4 page size with portrait or landscape orientation.

PRINTING:

- ⑥ Images must print quickly.
- ⑥ Images must be printable on a Postscript Level 1 printer.
- ⑥ Accompanying hard copy color printouts of your submissions should be included (or a sample if they are numerous).

These suggestions are intended only as a guide. Submissions are not necessarily accepted because they fit into any of the categories identified below. Images of similar themes and styles are encouraged and should be grouped together in your submission. Please remember that Corel strives to represent multicultural perspectives and peoples.

KEYWORDING:

Corel asks that any images which are accepted be keyworded.

Keywords are words that facilitate searching for a specific type of image by describing what the clipart image is. The keywords become part of the electronic file that contains the clipart image. For example a croissant might be keyworded as: food, bread, breakfast, pastry. We would also include information about what it looks like, for instance is it a black & white image or color? Is it a realistic depiction of something or a cartoon? Keywords are most useful if they are concepts that a person might use to locate a piece of clipart. Please follow the guidelines below so that our keywords are consistent.

GUIDELINES:

- Ⓞ All words should be singular unless it is a proper name
- Ⓞ Capitals should only be used for proper names
- Ⓞ Use gerunds for activities eg. walking, dancing
- Ⓞ No punctuation please
- Ⓞ Compound words should stay in the correct order (eg. Boy Scout not Scout, Boy)
- Ⓞ Try not to use abbreviations
- Ⓞ We cannot use any names that are products. (Eg. Jeep, Porsche, Rolodex)

The keywords may be submitted as part of the electronic file, a separate spreadsheet or a text listing.

NOTES:

Images must be submitted on one of the following media formats: CD Rom, 3.5" floppy disk or Zip Drive.

Due to the large volume of submissions, it will take approximately 4–6 weeks to process your submissions. All illustrators will be notified either by telephone, mail or email when the evaluation process has been completed.

If you live outside of Canada, you must include a customs/commercial invoice with your submissions. A sample is enclosed for your reference.

All shipping, duty and taxes must be prepaid by the submitting illustrator. Corel will not accept C.O.D. or UPS packages.

Corel does not return submissions regardless of whether or not they are accepted.
